JOURNEYMAN PLUMBER APPLICATION INFORMATION

Requirements for Credential

Per Wis. Stats. § 145.06, no person may engage in or work at plumbing in the state unless licensed to do so by the Department.

Per <u>Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.93</u> the plumbing activities that may be undertaken by a person who holds a credential as a licensed Journeyman Plumber shall be performed under the general supervision of a person who holds a Master Plumber license, Master Plumber Restricted license, or Utility Contractor license. A Journeyman Plumber who is working under the general supervision of a licensed Master Plumber Restricted or licensed Utility Contractor is limited to the type of plumbing installations associated with the specific license of the person providing the supervision.

AN APPLICATION IS NOT COMPLETE UNTIL ALL REQUIREMENTS FOR ONE SET OF QUALIFICATIONS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED:

- **A.** <u>WI Apprenticeship and Examination</u> Completion of an apprenticeship and passing the Journeyman Plumber license examination.
 - <u>Application and Fee</u>: Apply and pay fees online in LicensE, <u>https://license.wi.gov</u>. Fees will be calculated in LicensE. If needed, you can save your application and complete and submit it later. NOTE: If DSPS requests additional documents they must be uploaded within three (3) months from the date they were requested. Failure to do so may result in having to submit a new application and fees.
 - 2. <u>Plumbing Apprenticeship</u>: A person applying for a Journeyman Plumber license examination shall have completed a plumbing apprenticeship program recognized under <u>Wis. Stat. § 106.025</u> or the Federal Department of Labor. Upload a copy of a letter from the Wisconsin Bureau of Apprenticeship Standards stating that you have satisfied the requirements of a plumbing apprenticeship program in order to take the exam. If you have any questions about apprenticeship standards, please contact the Wisconsin Bureau of Apprenticeship Standards at <u>http://dwd.wisconsin.gov/apprenticeship/contacts.htm</u> or 608-733-3930.
 - 3. **Examination:** You will be made eligible to test after your application has been submitted and reviewed. If additional documents are required you will be made eligible to test after all documentation has been received and reviewed. A communication will be sent once you are made eligible to test.  - 2. <u>Plumbing Apprenticeship</u>: A person applying for a Journeyman Plumber license examination shall have completed an out of state plumbing apprenticeship 5-year program, including plumbing related instruction of a minimum of 576 hours, recognized under <u>Wis. Stat. § 106.025</u> or the Federal Department of Labor. Upload a copy of certificate of completion or equivalency from the Wisconsin Bureau of Apprenticeship Standards stating that you have satisfied the requirements of a plumbing apprenticeship program in order to take the exam. If you have any questions about apprenticeship standards, please contact the Wisconsin Bureau of Apprenticeship Standards at http://dwd.wisconsin.gov/apprenticeship/contacts.htm or 608-733-3930.
 - 3. Examination: You will be made eligible to test after your application has been submitted and reviewed. If additional documents are required you will be made eligible to test after all documentation has been received and reviewed. A communication will be sent once you are made eligible to test. - C. <u>Comity (Out-of-State) and Examination</u> Completion of an apprenticeship, passing the Journeyman Plumber license examination, and practiced for at least five (5) years under a journeyman plumber's license or equivalent license issued by another state.
 - <u>1.</u> <u>Application and Fees</u>: Apply and pay fees online in LicensE, <u>https://license.wi.gov</u>. Fees will be calculated in LicensE. If needed, you can save your application and complete and submit it later. NOTE: If DSPS requests additional documents they must be uploaded within three (3) months from the date they were requested. Failure to do so may result in having to submit a new application and fees.
 - 2. The Department shall accept for a journeyman plumber's examination a person to whom **all** of the following apply:
 - a. The person completed a plumbing apprenticeship under <u>Wis. Stat. § 106.025</u> or under the laws of any other state. **Upload a** copy of certificate of completion of plumbing apprenticeship.
 - b. The person passed a journeyman plumber's examination in any other state. (Complete <u>all</u> sections of Form 3126T on the next page.)
 - c. The person has practiced for at least five (5) years under a journeyman plumber's license or equivalent license issued by another state having licensure provisions governing plumbers that the department determines are substantially similar to the requirements under <u>Wis. Stat. ch. 145</u> and the rules promulgated under this chapter, and the person has not been the subject of any disciplinary actions related to that license or any other equivalent license. (Complete <u>all</u> sections of Form 3126T on the next page.)
- D. Wisconsin Master Plumber License to be exchanged for a Journeyman Plumber License A person who holds a Wisconsin Master Plumber license may, upon application to the Department, exchange his or her current Master Plumber license for a Wisconsin Journeyman Plumber license.
 - <u>Application and Fees</u>: Apply and pay fees online in LicensE, <u>https://license.wi.gov</u>. Fees will be calculated in LicensE. If needed, you can save your application and complete and submit it later. NOTE: If DSPS requests additional documents they must be uploaded within three (3) months from the date they were requested. Failure to do so may result in having to submit a new application and fees.
 - 2. <u>Master Plumber License</u>: Attach a copy of your Master Plumber license. Keep your original copy of your Master Plumber license.
