## ELEVATOR APPRENTICE REGISTRATION APPLICATION INFORMATION

#### **Requirements for Credential**

Per <u>Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.994</u>, the activities of an individual, who holds a registration issued by the Department as a registered Elevator Apprentice to erect, construct, alter, replace, maintain, repair, remove or dismantle conveyances shall be performed under the general supervision of a person who is a licensed Elevator Mechanic.

A person who holds a registration issued by the Department as a registered Elevator Apprentice may also:

- Maintain and repair conveyances and replace conveyance components and subsystems, except the replacement of hoist rope and governor ropes, shall be performed under the general supervision of a person who is a licensed Elevator Mechanic or a licensed Elevator Mechanic Restricted.
- Erect, construct, alter, replace, maintain, repair, remove or dismantle conveyances covered under ASME A18.1 and ASME A17.1 section 5.2 shall be performed under the general supervision of a person who is a licensed Elevator Mechanic or a licensed Lift Mechanic.

#### AN APPLICATION IS NOT COMPLETE UNTIL ALL OF THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED:

- <u>Application and Fees</u>: Apply and pay fees online in LicensE, <u>https://license.wi.gov</u>. Fees will be calculated in LicensE. If needed, you can save your application and complete and submit it later. NOTE: If DSPS requests additional documents they must be uploaded within three (3) months from the date they were requested. Failure to do so may result in having to submit a new application and pay fees.
- 2. <u>Elevator Apprenticeship</u>: A person applying for an Elevator Apprentice registration shall be indentured in an elevator apprenticeship program recognized under <u>Wis. Stat. ch. 106</u> or the Federal Department of Labor. Upload a copy of the apprenticeship contract or proof of elevator indentureship from the Wisconsin Bureau of Apprenticeship Standards or the Federal Department of Labor.
