Definitions of Direct Supervision:

HAS 6.14(3)

(3) "Direct supervision of unlicensed individuals" means:

(a) For purposes of monitoring unlicensed individuals who assist in the practice of speech-language pathology, providing direct observation and supervision of the clinical services provided by the individual to clients at least 50% of client contact time during the first 90 days of employment and no less than 10% thereafter. Direct supervision shall be scheduled and documented. Documentation of direct supervision shall include all of the following:

1. Identifying specific roles and tasks for the individual.

2. Ensuring that the tasks performed by the individual do not require the exercise of professional judgment or entail interpretation of results or the development or modification of treatment plans.

3. Providing appropriate training that is competency-based and specific to job performance.

4. Maintaining a record of direct supervision provided by the speech-language pathologist over the unlicensed individual who assists in the practice of speech-language pathology.

(b) For purposes of monitoring unlicensed individuals who assist in the practice of audiology, providing comprehensive, periodic and documented supervision that includes:

1. Identifying specific roles and tasks for the individual.

2. Ensuring that the tasks performed by the individual do not require the exercise of professional judgment or entail interpretation of results or the development or modification of treatment plans.

3. Providing appropriate training that is competency-based and specific to job performance.

DHS 129 (13) "Direct supervision" means that an RN or LPN is immediately available on the same unit, floor or wing as the nurse aide while the nurse aide is performing client-related services.

<u>DHS 129.03(17)</u> "General supervision" means at least intermittent face-to-face contact between supervisor and nurse aide, but does not require the continuous presence of the supervisor in the same area during client-related services.

DHS 159 (21) "Direct supervision" means supervision by a certified asbestos supervisor who is onsite during an asbestos abatement activity and readily available to observe and assist.

DHS 163 (25) "Direct supervision" means supervision by an individual who is on-site and readily available to observe and assist.

<u>DHS 101.03(173)</u> "Supervision," unless otherwise indicated in chs. <u>DHS 101</u> to <u>108</u>, means at least intermittent face-to-face contact between supervisor and assistant and a regular review of the assistant's work by the supervisor.

(2a) "Direct supervision" means being physically present at the time the trainee makes ear impressions or measurements of human hearing for the purpose of fitting or selling a hearing instrument or fits or sells a hearing instrument.

NUR 1 (7) "Direct supervision" means immediate availability to coordinate, direct and inspect the practice of another.

NUR 6 (6) "Direct supervision" means immediate availability to continually coordinate, direct and inspect at first hand the practice of another.

Phar 7.60 Definitions. (1) "Direct supervision" means immediate availability to continually coordinate, direct and inspect in real time the practice of another.

SPS 305 (19) "Direct supervision" means to assume the responsibility of an activity of others and its results by providing oversight and guidance at the site where the activity is being conducted.

SPS 180 (5) "Direct supervision" means immediate on-premises availability to continually coordinate, direct and inspect at first hand the practice of another.

<u>Chir 1.02(3)</u> "Direct, on-premises supervision" means that the treating chiropractor has ordered a specific patient care function to be performed by a specific person, and is present in the treatment facility while the patient care function is being performed, and is immediately available to exercise personal supervision of the patient care function if the person performing the function requests.

<u>NR 19.71(3m)</u> "Direct supervision" means the actual presence of the licensee or consulting veterinarian.

<u>NR 146.02(3)</u> "Direct supervision" means actual physical presence and supervision by a Wisconsin licensed individual water well driller during all water well drilling activities, by a Wisconsin licensed individual heat exchange driller during all heat exchange drilling activities, or by a Wisconsin licensed individual pump installer during all pump installing activities.

<u>DHS 163.03(25)</u> "Direct supervision" means supervision by an individual who is on-site and readily available to observe and assist.

<u>FD 1.013(4)</u> "Personal supervision" means immediate availability to continually coordinate, direct and inspect at first hand the practice of another.

(5) "Supervision" means regularly to coordinate, direct and inspect the practice of another.

STATUTES:

448.22 (1) In this section, "supervision" means the use of the powers of direction and decision to coordinate, direct, and inspect the accomplishments of another, and to oversee the implementation of the anesthesiologist's intentions.
