

Descriptions of the WI ePDMP Upcoming Releases: Prescriber Metrics Notifications


This enhancement includes two automated notifications:

- 1. When prescribers have not viewed their prescriber metrics in the past 90 days (both email and pop-up on the website).
- 2. When prescribers whose prescriber metrics have exceeded the threshold in certain areas (email only). Rules to be determined by the Board so the ePDMP administrators will be able to set them up later.
