Metrics Reviewing Activities

Only 2% of all active Healthcare Professional Accounts have viewed their metrics within the past 90 days (July 2020).

Count of Active HCP accounts - 36,931

Count of Active HCP accounts who have never viewed their metrics - 32,462 (~88% of active HCPs)

Count of Active HCP accounts who's most recent viewing of their prescriber metrics was more than 90 days ago - 3,623 (~10% if active HCPs)

Count of Active HCP accounts who's most recent viewing of their prescriber metrics was more than 180 days ago - 2,964 (~8% if active HCPs)
