<u>FINDINGS</u>

- 1. On May 7, 2021, the Department of Justice, Drug Enforcement Administration published its temporary scheduling order in the Federal Register listing Serdexmethylphenidate into schedule IV of the federal Controlled Substances Act. The scheduling action is effective May 7, 2021.
- 2. The Controlled Substances Board did not receive an objection to similarly listing Serdexmethylphenidate as a schedule IV under ch. 961, Stats. within 30 days of the date of publication in the federal register of the interim final order listing Serdexmethylphenidate as a schedule IV controlled substance.
- 3. The Controlled Substances Board will promulgate a final rule, without making the determinations or findings required by ss. 961.11(1), (1m), (1r) and (2) or s. 961.15 and omitting the notice of proposed rule making, listing Serdexmethylphenidate as a schedule IV controlled substance.

ORDER

Pursuant to s. 961.11(4), Stats., the Controlled Substances Board by affirmative action similarly treats Serdexmethylphenidate under chapter 961, Stats. by creating the following:

CSB 2.81 Addition of Serdexmethylphenidate to schedule IV. Section 961.20 (2m) (em), Stats., is created to read:

961.20 (2m) (em) Serdexmethylphenidate.

This order shall take effect upon publication in the Administrative Register. The order expires upon promulgation of a final rule.
