SECTION 1. HAS 5.015 is created to read:

HAS 5.015 Definition. In this chapter, "telehealth" means patient care, treatment, or services is provided through the use of information exchanged from one site to another via electronic communications.

SECTION 2. HAS 5.02 (1m) is created to read:

(1m) The standards of practice and professional conduct apply to a licensee regardless of whether health care service is provided in person or by telehealth.

SECTION 3. HAS 6.175 (4m) is created to read:

HAS 6.175 (4m) "Telehealth" means patient care, treatment or services is provided through the use of information exchanged from one site to another via electronic communications.

SECTION 4. HAS 6.18 (4) is created to read:
