been busy in several areas over the past few months. I would like to highlight some of the Board's recent activities.


Paul Abegglen, Dan Williams and I had the opportunity to attend the annual meeting of the National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN) in August. Please see Paul's article for more details.

Peter Kallio represents the Sheryl Krause, MS, RN, CEN, Controlled ACNS-BC on the Substance Board. We thank

him for his work in this area, which is so crucial to our goal of protecting the public.

BON Legislation and Rules Committee continues to work on updating N1, Approval for Schools of Nursing. We have two approved scope statements. The first allows the Board to clarify requirements for school approvals, including regional vs. national school accreditation and approval for schools of

nursing with post licensure programs. The second scope statement permits us to make revisions to curriculum and rotation requireclinical ments

#### The Status of the Compact in Wisconsin

As mentioned in the email that went out to Wisconsin nurses this past summer, on July 20, 2017 the eNLC was enacted. On that date Wisconsin was not one of the 26 states that legislatively had enacted the eNLC. That means that Wisconsin would remain in the old Nurse Licensure Compact (NLC) with only three other states (Colorado, New Mexico, Rhode Island). The Board is pleased to report that legislation is being pursued for Wisconsin to join the eNLC. The Senate Bill number is

As mentioned in the email that went out to Wisconsin arses this past summer, on July 20, 2017 the eNLC as enacted. On that date Wisconsin was not one of the 5 states that legislatively had enacted the eNLC. That 2017 Senate Bill 417 and the Assembly Bill is 2017 Assembly Bill 500 and they were introduced before the Assembly and the Senate the week of September 18, 2017.

As previously cited, the Board of Nursing supports Wisconsin joining the eNLC and encourages you to seek out your local Assembly and Senate leaders to express your support for the passing of those Bills.

Finally, we have continued to evaluate the benefits of joining the enhanced nurse licensure compact (eNLC).

This updated compact was released by the NCSBN in March of 2015 and adopted in May of 2015. You may recall that the Board of Nursing discussed the new compact at the July 2015 meeting, and decided, at that time, that the timing was not right to pursue the new compact. Fast forward to June of 2017, when an informational hearing was held to discuss the eNLC. Based on several factors, including the written feedback you provided prior to the meeting, as well as the support for the new compact during the meeting, the Board voted unanimously to support it.

### **Enforcement Actions of the Board of Nursing**

#### Disciplinary options available to the Board:

violation.

Limitation of License: Imposes conditions and requirements upon the licensee, imposes restrictions on the scope of practice, or both.

Suspension: Completely and absolutely withdraws and withholds for a period of time all rights, privileges and authority previously conferred by the credential.

Revocation: To completely and absolutely terminate the credential and all rights, privileges and authority previously conferred by the credential.

#### Non-disciplinary options available to the Board:

Reprimand: A public warning of the licensee for a Administrative Warning: Issued if violation is of a minor nature, a first occurrence and the warning will adequately protect the public. The issuance of an Administrative Warning is public information, however the reason for issuance is not.

> Remedial Education Order: Issued when there is reason to believe that the deficiency can be corrected with remedial education, while sufficiently protecting the public.
