The Importance of Nursing Documentation

Do you recall the statement, "if it's not documented, it's not done"? Documentation remains a crucial component of the nursing profession. Documentation requirements have become somewhat burdensome and time-consuming, making it difficult at times to appreciate the value of complete and effective documentation. This can become particularly challenging with the implementation of Electronic Health Record (EHR) systems.

Nurses have both a legal and professional obligation to provide high quality care and complete documentation pertinent to a patient's course of treatment. In reviewing cases brought to the Board of Nursing, documentation is one of the most important elements during the review process to determine the need for disciplinary action. Lack of documentation not only makes it

difficult for the Board to review the factual basis of a complaint, but may also be a violation in and of itself. Remember, documentation is a vital tool of communication, so be wise and ensure that you document the care you deliver.

Enforcement Actions of the Board of Nursing

The Board of Nursing, with help from staff at the Department of Safety and Professional Services, can take action against nurses licensed in the state to help protect the profession and the citizens of Wisconsin. There are several options the Board can use; some are disciplinary other are non-disciplinary and they include:

Disciplinary options available to the Board:

Reprimand - A public warning of the licensee for a **Administrative Warning** - Issued if violation is of a minor violation.

Limitation of License - Imposes conditions and requirements upon the licensee, imposes restrictions on the scope of practice, or both.

Suspension - Completely and absolutely withdraws and withholds for a period of time all rights, privileges and authority previously conferred by the credential.

Revocation - To completely and absolutely terminate the credential and all rights, privileges and authority previously conferred by the credential.

Administrative Warning - Issued if violation is of a minor nature, a first occurrence and the warning will adequately protect the public. The issuance of an Administrative Warning is public information, however the reason for issuance is not.

Non-disciplinary options available to the Board:

Remedial Education Order - Issued when there is reason to believe that the deficiency can be corrected with remedial education, while sufficiently protecting the public.
