The length of the public session varies dependent on the number of agenda items rate for first time test takers or all test submitted, so I would encourage you to review the agenda in advance. Schools that do not achieve an 80% pass takers are required to provide an explanation or analysis of NCLEX pass rates and their plan to meet the NCLEX pass rate standard. If a school does not reach 80% for first time test takers but meets or exceeds 80% for all test takers, the board reviews the submission, but no formal action is taken.

Dr. Akiko Maeda offered the keynote presenting a framework on effective workforce skill assessments to ensure a patient-centered focus. Following Dr. Maeda's lecture and panel discussion exploring her work, the Marijuana Regulatory Guidelines Committee offered education on THC, preliminary information related to current testing limitations and suggestions states might utilize to guide dialogue around the regulatory implications of marijuana use. Other noteworthy presentations were the utilization of simulation, and consequences causes occupational licensing, and an overview of various state's monitoring programs.

I observed a few themes from the conference: 1. The NCSBN was very

aware of current issues and offered relevant education and dialogue around topics. 2. Generally speaking, the current political sentiments are demonstrating anti-regulation trends which will require boards to critically evaluate procedures to continue to ensure safe and appropriate practices. 3. There was enthusiasm about the compact and the speed of adoption to date, recognizing there is more work to be done in this arena.

As member new to Wisconsin board as of spring 2017, I appreciated the opportunity to attend learn at this conference. Networking with professionals from other states allowed me the opportunity to begin to understand both similarities and differences among states related to practice and regulation. I encouraged that so many nurses as well as non-nurse board members from across the nation gathered with the purpose to create an environment that supports safe nursing regulations which protects the public.

## **Enforcement Actions of the Board of Nursing**

The Board of Nursing, with help from staff at the Department of Safety and Professional Services, can take action against nurses licensed in the state to help protect the profession and the citizens of Wisconsin. #### Disciplinary options available to the Board:

**Reprimand:** A public warning of the licensee for a violation.

**Limitation of License:** Imposes conditions and requirements upon the licensee, imposes restrictions on the scope of practice, or both.

**Suspension:** Completely and absolutely withdraws and withholds for a period of time all rights, privileges and authority previously conferred by the credential.

**Revocation:** To completely and absolutely terminate the credential and all rights, privileges and authority previously conferred by the credential.

#### Non-disciplinary options available to the Board:

Administrative Warning: Issued if violation is of a minor nature, a first occurrence and the warning will adequately protect the public. The issuance of an Administrative Warning is public information, however the reason for issuance is not.

**Remedial Education Order:** Issued when there is reason to believe that the deficiency can be corrected with remedial education, while sufficiently protecting the public.
