Nursing meeting was held there in August; it went well thanks to the planning and efforts of DSPS staff members! As always, I would encourage you to participate in public meetings of the Board of Nursing and related subgroups. We value your engagement and feedback. Check the Board of Nursing website for meeting dates and agendas.

One of the most recent projects we have started is the creation of an online education course specific to the Wisconsin Nurse Practice Act. A small workgroup of the Board of Nursing meets to select the content for the course, which will include the history of nursing in Wisconsin. Once completed, the course will be available on the National State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN) website.

Legislative Update

The revision of N1, Approval for Schools of Nursing, has been finalized and went into effect on September 1st. The School of Professional Nursing definition now includes graduate and post-licensure bachelor degree schools. Several sections were clarified, including verification of clinical opportunities for students and rules for emergency faculty exceptions. Rules pertaining to simulation were added to provide guidance for schools utilizing this option. These are just a few of the highlights. Wisconsin Prescription Drug Monitoring Program Update

The Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional WI ePDMP Usage by Advanced Practice Nurse Prescribers Services (DSPS) continues to enhance the features of the Wisconsin Enhanced Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (WI ePDMP) and analyze prescribing trends based on the dispensing data reported to the WI ePDMP.

There are currently 4,335 advanced practice nurse prescribers (APNP) registered for the WI ePDMP. In the month of July 2018, APNP users submitted 43,498 patient queries, Continued on page 3...

Controlled Substances Board WI ePDMP Report

In July, the Controlled Substances Board (CSB) released the Q2 2018 WI ePDMP Report, including trend analysis of controlled substance dispensing in

Wisconsin. The report highlights a 5% decrease in the total number of monitored drug prescriptions dispensed and a 9% decrease in the number of opioid prescriptions dispensed over the past 12 months. Analysis also shows a 32% decrease in the average monthly doctor shopping alerts, an 18% decrease in the average monthly high morphine milligram equivalents (MME) alerts, and a 13% decrease in the average monthly opioid-benzodiazepine alerts over the same time period.

The report also highlights results of the WI ePDMP user satisfaction survey conducted in April of 2018. The survey indicates that most users are satisfied with the WI ePDMP.

Seventy-seven percent of respondents reported overall satisfaction with the WI ePDMP, providing responses of either "Satisfied" or "Very Satisfied." Satisfaction rates are slightly higher for those who are accessing the WI ePDMP via EHR integration, with close to 45% of EHR integration users indicating that they are "Very Satisfied" with the WI ePDMP, compared to 40% of those accessing the PDMP via the website.

Survey results suggest that using the WI ePDMP is influencing the behavior of healthcare professionals. Out of the 6,000 survey respondents, 44% indicated that, after reviewing information in the PDMP, they had spoken with a patient about controlled substance use, and 37% of respondents indicated that they had denied or modified a patient's prescription. Only 8% of respondents indicated that they had dismissed a patient from care, but 10% to 21% of respondents indicated that they had referred a patient for substance abuse treatment, behavioral health treatment, or pain management.

WI ePDMP Prescriber Feature Spotlight

Prescriber features have been added to help enhance the WI ePDMP as a communication and prescribing practice assessment tool. The prescriber features include:

- Prescriber Led Alerts, which allow prescribers to enter alerts on a patient record in the WI ePDMP indicating 1) a treatment agreement, 2) a treatment agreement violation, and 3) an overdose incident;
- Prescriber Metrics Reports, which display a summary of an individual prescriber's prescription and patient alert metrics for the last 100 days in comparison to other prescribers of the same specialty;
- Medical Coordinator Access, which allows staff who medically coordinate Wisconsin prescribers to access the Prescriber Metrics Report of the prescribers they oversee.

Throughout the meeting there were many references to the multiple resources that are available on the NCSBN website (<u>www.ncsbn.org</u>). The NCSBN website houses documents, brochures, guidelines and other resources which can be utilized in various settings across multiple jurisdictions. I encourage you to go to this website and check out the information that is available.

The CEO, David Benton, PhD, recounted that we are strong because the founders who started NCSBN created a foundation for the future by not being satisfied with the status quo. He noted that nursing continues to be the most trusted profession and regulation is essential to maintaining that status. However, he commented we need to better articulate our professional responsibility through legislative efforts. He challenged the profession of nursing to utilize our strengths in regulation, allowing us to grow and become stronger through shaping proactive public policy versus reactive public policy. We all need to think and act differently by working together to create/develop the future.

Enforcement Actions of the Board of Nursing

The Board of Nursing, with help from staff at the Department of Safety and Professional Services, can take action against nurses licensed in the state to help protect the profession and the citizens of Wisconsin. Disciplinary options available to the Board:

Reprimand: A public warning of the licensee for a violation.

Limitation of License: Imposes conditions and requirements upon the licensee, imposes restrictions on the scope of practice, or both.

Suspension: Completely and absolutely withdraws and withholds for a period of time all rights, privileges and authority previously conferred by the credential.

Revocation: To completely and absolutely terminate the credential and all rights, privileges and authority previously conferred by the credential.

Non-disciplinary options available to the Board:

Administrative Warning: Issued if violation is of a minor nature, a first occurrence and the warning will adequately protect the public. The issuance of an Administrative Warning is public information, however the reason for issuance is not.

Remedial Education Order: Issued when there is reason to believe that the deficiency can be corrected with remedial education, while sufficiently protecting the public.
