As liaison to the Controlled Substances Board (CSB), I report to meetings every other month. The Board is comprised of representatives from various boards including Dentistry, Medical, Pharmacy, and Nursing. The Board also has membership from the Attorney General's office, the Department of Health Services, the Department of Agriculture,

Trade and Consumer Protection, and two gubernatorial appointees including a psychiatrist and a pharmacologist. The CSB meets to keep up with the scheduling of controlled

Another duty of the CSB is to analyze data generated by the state Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) to monitor and make recommendations about prescribing practices in Wisconsin. We are currently searching for outlier prescribers and making referrals to appropriate boards to investigate controlled substance prescribing practices that may be suspicious or critically dangerous. *Continued on page 4 ...*

Marijuana: Implications for Nursing

Over the last number of decades, cultural acceptance related to the use of marijuana (both medical and recreational) has grown. This change in social mores creates a need for healthcare, research, legislative and educational systems to coalesce to develop an evidence based, informed approach to marijuana.

The National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN), with input from multiple sources, recognized a lack of research specifically related to medical marijuana. The gap in evidence was noted in various aspects of care: efficacy, indications, dosing, route, long term effects, education, and nursing implications. To address the issue, NCSBN appointed the Medical Marijuana Nursing Guidelines Committee to develop recommendations and guidelines associated with medical marijuana. This committee completed a scientific literature review, connected with experts, and investigated current legislation. The July

2018 supplement of the Journal of Nursing Regulation offers a synopsis of its findings and is an important body of work that begins to inform, and guide practices related to medical marijuana.

Recreational use of marijuana is complex and another facet of this dialogue, needing additional investigation to fully comprehend implications. Important to note is that while some states have legalized recreational use of marijuana, the federal government still interprets recreational use of marijuana illegal. However, they have chosen not to prosecute cases of this nature. Additionally, there is contradiction between federal and state laws associated with the classification of marijuana. The federal government classifies cannabis as a Schedule I controlled substance, which limits research funds available. Legislative efforts to modify the current federal classification have not been successful to date. As evidence continues to evolve regarding marijuana (both medical and recreational), the Board of Nursing is committed to being informed as possible to assist decision making that creates safe environments for both patients and nurses.

Legislative Update

During the December Board of Nursing meeting, the Board approved a scope statement to allow the Legislation and Rules Committee to begin work on revisions to N4, Licensure of Nurse-Midwives. This rule first went into effect in January of 1982; the current version was published in 2012. Once the scope statement is approved

by the governor, the Legislation and Rules Committee will meet to discuss potential revisions. If you have an interest in the content of this rule, you are encouraged to attend the Legislation and Rules Committee meetings. Public comment is invited during each meeting. Committee meetings are scheduled as needed so please check the website for dates, times and meeting agendas.

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Enforcement Actions of the Board of Nursing

The Board of Nursing, with help from staff at the Department of Safety and Professional Services, can take action against nurses licensed in the state to help protect the profession and the citizens of Wisconsin. Disciplinary options available to the Board:

Reprimand: A public warning of the licensee for a violation.

Limitation of License: Imposes conditions and requirements upon the licensee, imposes restrictions on the scope of practice, or both.

Suspension: Completely and absolutely withdraws and withholds for a period of time all rights, privileges and authority previously conferred by the credential.

Revocation: To completely and absolutely terminate the credential and all rights, privileges and authority previously conferred by the credential.

Non-disciplinary options available to the Board:

Administrative Warning: Issued if violation is of a minor nature, a first occurrence and the warning will adequately protect the public. The issuance of an Administrative Warning is public information, however the reason for issuance is not.

Remedial Education Order: Issued when there is reason to believe that the deficiency can be corrected with remedial education, while sufficiently protecting the public.
