DSPS Launches New, Improved Platform for Occupational Licensing

After completing years of education and training, aspiring health care professionals typically have one more step before they can get to work: Getting a license.

In an effort to streamline the license application process, the Wisconsin agency responsible for issuing most occupational licenses is launching a new, self-guided, online application platform called LicensE. Starting on May 16, most individuals seeking their initial health license (e.g. nurses, physicians, pharmacists, etc.) will use LicensE for their application. Other professions and renewals will transition to the platform in later phases. A list of licenses launching on May 16 is available HERE.

LicensE will automate the application process. The new platform will replace paper forms and will enable applicants to enter their data directly into this system. This will give customers more control over their applications and access to more information about their application status. It will also reduce data entry errors. It is the most significant improvement for Wisconsin occupational licensing in more than a decade.

"We are excited to bring occupational licensing into the modern era," said DSPS Secretary Dawn Crim. "By shifting to an online application process, LicensE will give our customers more control over their applications. It will also enable us to operate in a way that our customers expect and deserve in this day and age."

Crim recognizes that applying for an occupational license can be confusing, as it often requires submitting forms, multiple documents, exam results, and payment. She says that is why the department is developing user guides, demo videos, and other resources to accompany the LicensE launch.

"This is a new system, and we are building out a library of tools to help our applicants navigate LicensE easily and successfully," Crim said. Some of those resources will be available on <u>license.wi.gov</u> when LicensE launches on May 16, and others will be added over subsequent phases of the project.

Note: LicensE is launching for most health occupations. Business, trade, and manufactured homes licenses are not included in the LicensE launch on May 16. No renewals for any DSPS licenses are included in the LicensE launch on May 16.
