Electrical in Camping Units

We already have electrical codes specified under SPS 324, now we have a whole new set of codes in addition to this? Are they completely different?

There are three additional subsections which differentiates SPS 327 electrical standards from SPS 324.

SPS 327.51(3) Except as provided in s. SPS 327.11, the inspection of the electrical construction of a camping unit is not required. (Note: **SPS 327.11** requires rough and final electrical inspections)

SPS 327.51(4) No more than one receptacle outlet is required to be installed for the entire countertop space of a kitchen in a camping unit.

SPS 327.51(6) The ampacity of a conductor providing service to a camping unit and rating of the service disconnecting means may not be less than 50 amperes.

How do I inspect for electrical roughs and finals?

The same as a one or two family dwelling, except:

- The kitchen countertop space is only required to have one receptacle.
- See SPS 327.26 for smoke detector locations. Not required to be hardwired.
- See SPS 327.27 for Carbon monoxide alarm location. Only required to be hardwired w/ battery backup if the unit has electricity provided by a public utility.
